Lactoferrin inhibits angiogenesis in vitro and in vivo. Lactoferrin is an abundant iron-binding protein found in milk. Recent studies suggest that lactoferrin can reduce the growth of tumors. The mechanisms by which lactoferrin exerts these effects are unknown. In this study, we examined whether lactoferrin could affect the growth of new blood vessels. Angiogenesis was induced in mice using the air pouch model. Lactoferrin (40 microg/g body weight) or saline was injected into the air pouch at the beginning of the experiment. Blood vessel growth was significantly inhibited in mice injected with lactoferrin. An in vitro model of angiogenesis (endothelial cell tube formation) showed that lactoferrin (500 microg/ml) reduced the number of tubes formed. To evaluate the ability of lactoferrin to inhibit the growth of new blood vessels in vivo, we injected lactoferrin or saline into the air pouches of mice that had been injected with histamine to stimulate angiogenesis. Angiogenesis was significantly reduced in the air pouches of mice that were injected with lactoferrin. These data suggest that lactoferrin is an endogenous inhibitor of angiogenesis and that it may act directly on the

The Supreme Court's recent decision to hear its first cases from the current crop of requests for extraordinary writs has given people in the criminal-justice system and their families new hope. For all of us whose loved ones have been denied access to the US court system, we are glad that finally, our voices will be heard. The justices' decision to hear cases like these is significant. The idea that the legal system can be so antiquated that pre-incarceration death row prisoners, those facing mandatory life without parole sentences and those awaiting execution are even more powerless than those awaiting trial has far-reaching implications for us all. Not only have these cases exposed a serious problem – a system which allows for a population of Americans who face lengthy sentences, or who are awaiting execution, and who cannot make their voices heard – they have also demonstrated a system that should not exist. But, while this may seem like a welcomed change, it is just the latest in a long line of legal struggles to fix the legal system. It is now clear that the American legal system is in desperate need of an overhaul. The US Supreme Court recently stated that it is in need of a "fix". We have been telling the story of our extraordinary family for the last decade. At the time of our daughter's arrest, we found ourselves caught in a legal limbo that seemed to go on for years. We were told that our daughter was an illegal immigrant, that she had no right to a court hearing or to even know why she had been arrested. This is one of the reasons we are pleading for innocence on her behalf. After years in court, our daughter's case was dismissed. And while it was dismissed, she was transferred to a federal prison camp. So, we were prepared to deal with the added complication of a federal trial. We told my husband that we would do whatever
